Field Trip Details

The students in grade three will be attending a field trip to the Ukrainian Heritage Village on Friday, June 19th. Students need to come early that day, arriving to school by 7:30am in order for us to leave by 7:45am. We will be arriving back to school in time for the busses at the end of the day.

Students will be involved in outdoor activities which allow them to experience the rich heritage of the life of a pioneer in the early years of Alberta's history. Students will need clothing appropriate for spending the entire day outdoors in spring weather. They should be dressed in layers and should be prepared for the weather including a hat, sunscreen and bug spray (already applied). In the event that there is a chance of rain, students should also bring an umbrella and/or raincoat along. It can be very muddy there so students require footwear that would not be damaged by mud. Students will also need a bagged lunch and a water bottle both with their name clearly marked.
