

Junior High Students Eligibility Requirements

For all Junior High extracurricular activities (including any sports teams, field trips and Grade 9 Farewell) students must meet the eligibility requirements determined by the school administration and the trip/sports coordinator. In determining eligibility, the principal in consultation with the trip/sports coordinator and other school staff, can deny a student's participation in any of these activities. This will apply to all students in Junior High. Students' eligibility is evaluated across four categories, with specific criteria outlined for each category as outlined below:

Good Behavioral Standing

- Complies with school rules and student code of conduct.
- Embodies Catholic values and the values of Sacred Heart School.
- Demonstrates good behavior when in class and on school grounds.
- Has no significant disciplinary actions (including repeated detentions or suspensions).
- Exhibits respect for staff, peers and school policies.

Good Financial Standing

- No outstanding school fees on School Cash; this includes but is not limited to extracurricular activities, electives, busing and technology fees.
- Fees for the whole family must be paid in full.

Good Academic Standing

- Maintains an average deemed satisfactory, based on each student's known academic ability.
- Displays consistent effort in their coursework including completing assignments and participating in class activities.
- Adheres to deadlines by submitting assignments and projects and other work on time.

Good Attendance Standing

- No unexcused absences.
- Minimal lates in all classes.
- Regularly attends all classes and avoids excessive absences that could impact their academic performance.
