

Please remind your child to keep practising their music. Have a great Easter! Mrs. Sieg





What is a Family School Liaison Worker (FSLW) in my STAR school?

Who Are FSLWs?

Family School Liaison Workers (FSLWs) are caring professionals who support the emotional, social, and mental well-being of students and their families. We work as part of the school team to create safe, supportive, and inclusive school environments.

What Do We Do?

- Provide short-term individual support for students dealing with stress, anxiety, grief, friendship challenges, or emotional struggles.
- Support families with parenting resources, connection to community agencies, and advocacy.
- Offer classroom and group programming to build social-emotional skills like self-regulation, empathy, and problem-solving.
- Help during tough times—whether it's a family crisis, mental health concern, or school refusal.
- Collaborate with teachers and staff to support student success.

When to Connect with Us

- · Your child seems withdrawn, anxious, or overwhelmed
- There are changes at home (divorce, death, move, etc.)
- You're looking for parenting strategies or community resources
- You are worried about your child's school attendance or peer relationships
