Dear Parents/Guardians:

The junior high students will be writing their exams June 20-26. It is essential that all students be aware of the following procedures:

- Report to homerooms first thing in the morning for attendance and instructions from teachers. Exams will begin at 9:00 am. Students are expected to be on time and arrive with the appropriate materials (pens, pencils, calculators etc.). **ELECTRONIC DEVICES WILL NOT BE ALLOWED IN THE EXAM ROOM. PLEASE ENSURE YOUR CHILD HAS A CALCULATOR.** Students may bring water bottles and appropriate literature to read if they finish early.
- All textbooks must be turned in before exams begin each day.
- Students **must** stay in the exam room until 10:20 am (9:30 am on Monday, June 23)
- **Once dismissed from the exam, students will be expected to leave the school.** If it is your intention to have your son/daughter stay at the school for the remainder of the day in a supervised study hall from 12:25 – 3:15 p.m., **please contact Kathy Robinson to add the reverse permission consent to SchoolCash for your signature.**

Here are the current roles and responsibilities of the School Council. Please keep in mind we are a small community and we work together. If you think you can help with a position but are concerned about all the duties, just let us know. We help each other out.

Current open positions: Treasurer, Vice Chair, Fundraising assistant (help with Fundraising Coordinator).

Chairperson

The Chairperson of the School Council will Chair all meetings of the School Council. Coordinate with the principal to establish meeting agendas. Communicate with the principal on a regular basis. Call regular School Council meetings.

Decide all matters relating to rules of order at the meetings. Ensure compliance with current School Council operating procedures. Ensure that minutes are recorded and maintained.

Have general supervision of all activities of the School Council. Be the official spokesperson of the School Council.

Ensure there is regular communication with the school community, beyond those who attend meetings.

Stay informed about STAR School Board policies that impacts School Council. Prepare an annual report in conformance with the Regulations.

Vice Chairperson

The Vice-Chairperson of the School Council will aid the Chair and undertake tasks assigned by the Chair.

In the event of the Chair being unavailable, fulfill the Chair's responsibilities.

Secretary

The Secretary of the School Council will act as a recorder at each meeting and ensure the minutes accurately reflect the directions agreed to at the School Council meeting. In the absence of the secretary, the School Council shall

choose a recording

secretary for the meeting. Have signing authority on any financial accounts together with the Chair

and/or the treasurer.

Treasurer

The Treasurer of the School Council will keep accurate records of all financial transactions. Be responsible for the deposits of all monies paid to the School Council in

whatever financial account the School Council utilizes.

Be responsible for monitoring the movement and allocation of funds. Present a full detailed account of receipts, disbursements, and account balances to

the School Council at regular meetings, and whenever requested by the School Council, and prepare the financial statements for the annual report.

Have signing authority on any financial accounts together with the Chairperson and/or Secretary.

Fundraising Coordinator

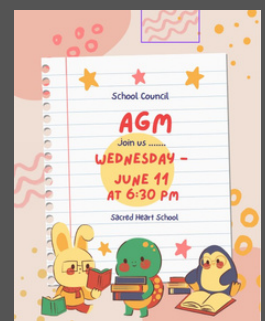
The Fundraising Coordinator of the School Council will gather information and present ideas/projects to the executive and parents at any regular school council meeting. Organize fundraising.

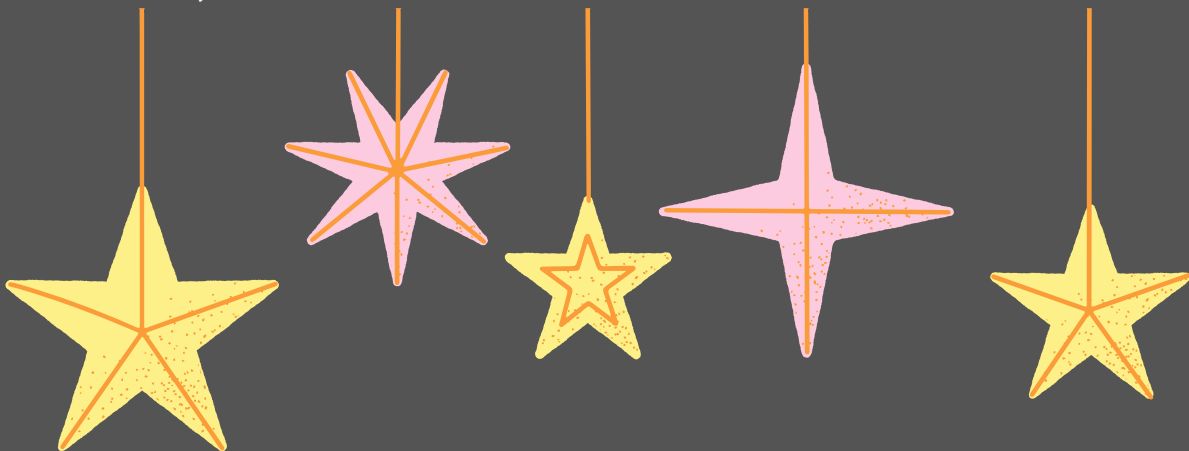
